What to do first

1. **Call A-Plus Bail Bonds:** (888) 694-6008. Agents are available most hours, 7 days per week, depending on staff availability.
2. **Ask where the person is being held.** Get the jail, county, and booking status if available.
3. **Do not guess.** Write down the exact legal name, date of birth, and booking number.
4. **Identify a cosigner.** The cosigner may need ID and basic contact/employment information.
5. **Ask about payment and signing.** A-Plus provides bail by phone, at jail, and online document signing.

Information to have ready

- Full legal name of defendant
- Date of birth
- Jail or county where held
- Booking number, if known
- Bail amount, if known
- Court date or charge, if known
- Cosigner name and phone

Cost and process notes

- **Premium:** Washington bail bond premium is typically 10% of the full bail amount. Example: \$5,000 bail usually means a \$500 premium.
- **Release options:** Depending on the case, release may involve cash bond, surety bond, property bond, own recognizance, or citation release.
- **Collateral:** Not every case requires collateral. A licensed agent can explain what applies to the specific bond.
- **Legal help:** Bail agents cannot provide legal advice, but can provide attorney referrals.

Bail amount x 10% = estimated premium
